





All About Elephant

The elephant is a strong animal. It has two long white teeth. They are called tusks. The elephant also has a very long nose which is called a trunk. It has huge, fan-like ears. They help them hear sounds from very far and also to drive away flies! The mother elephant has one baby every four years. The baby weighs almost 100kg. That is big baby! An hour after its birth, the baby elephant can walk. The father elephant gathers grass or breaks a few branches for the baby to eat. The baby elephant remains close to the mother. When the babies are 11 year old, the father elephant leaves the herd. Elephants love to eat grass, leaves, bamboo shoots, bark and roots. They also like sugarcane and banana. Elephants live in families, sometimes as big as twenty members. They also communicate with each other and take care of each other. Elephants are hunted for their tusks. These gentle giants need protection. In many countries, there are special laws to protect them.
