Note:- Summer break starts from 4 June 2018 to 1 July 2018 (school reopens on 16 July 2018).



- Holiday home work submission date for class IV is July 25 2018



Fast Water Facts

- 1. About 71 % of Earth's surface is covered with water.
- 2. The oceans have 97 % of all Earth's water, which is saline. That leaves only 3 % fresh water.
- 3. Fresh water exists in the air as water vapour, in rivers and in lakes, in ice caps and in glaciers, in the ground as soil moisture and in aquifers.
- 4. Not all of the fresh water is available for humans to use. In fact, out of all the fresh water, only 0.03 % can be used.

MATHS

It is rightly said that 'Water is Life'; and to save our life, we need to save water as well. Water Conservation includes all the policies, strategies and activities made to protectand manage the water environment, the natural resource fresh water and to meet the current and future human demand.

The main goals of water conservation are:-

- Reduction in water loss, use and waste of resources.
- Avoiding damage to water quality; and
- Using improved water management practices that result in enhanced beneficial use of water.


One strategy in water conservation is Rain water harvesting. Rain Water Harvesting can be defined as an activity of direct collection of rain water and its storage; aimed at using it again. Digging ponds, expanding water reservoir and installing rain water catching ducts and filtration systems on homes are different methods of harvesting rain water.

Rain water harvesting is considered the answer to India's water woes. The Rain Water Harvesting (RWH) scheme, a brain child of Tamil Naidu government has helped people in water starved regions. In the past decade it has won support from activists and local residents who were earlier majorly dependent on ground water for their daily needs.

Sarina lived in the Sohra village, also known as Cherrapunji, in Tamil Naidu. Rain water harvesting scheme brought huge benefits for her family and her village.

The following table and graph, shows the amount of Rain Water harvested, through roof top "rain water harvesting" in Sarina's village over the last year.
