Admission

- 1. School Transport available subject to availability of Seats and shall not be as a matter of right.
- All students using the school bus are expected to be on the stop at least five minute before the arrival time of the bus.

- The bus teacher and the bus monitors are responsible for maintaining discipline in the buses. Any offence in the bus must be reported to the Principal.
